Overview

The Zebra P4T printer is the first-ever mobile thermal transfer printer. Now, mobile thermal transfer printing brings you durability as well as the benefits of point-of-application efficiency and accuracy.

These easy-to-wear and carry printers are ideal for indoor and outdoor applications. You can print labels where you need them, when you need them, resulting in enhanced data and asset-tracking accuracy by ensuring the right label is applied to the right item.


Its rugged build is tolerant to multiple drops up to 5' to concrete. It has a memory of 8 MB and uses a USB 2.0, serial or Bluetooth connection.

Portable Printing Application

With the portable printing application, users can produce labels that track assets or supplies within the VA. Our team specially configures the Zebra P4T portable TTR barcode printers to print permanent labels. The mobile device used for this application has a special printing program for use with the P4T. You will use the mobile device to scan rather than type the information for the fields using barcodes that have the information encoded in them. You will scan in the header information and the serial number. Once everything is scanned into the fields and as long as printer is on, you can print the labels immediately. Now you have a durable label that presents the title, EE number and serial number.
